## TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Matches will be played according to the current rules.
2. Play will be on a group basis with matches played in groups of six commencing at 9.30 a.m.
  - The two players topping each group will play in Class 1.
  - The players finishing third and fourth will play in Class 2.
  - The players finishing fifth and sixth will play in Class 3.
3. The seeding of players will be based on available Ulster rankings. The Referee retains the right to change the format if necessary.
4. All matches shall be the best of five games. All competitors will be required to umpire matches.
5. The Round 2 graded competitions will be based on round robin matches. The groups will be in 3 man groups with one to qualify followed by straight knock-out. The Referee retains the right to change the format if necessary.
6. All competitors must report to the booking in desk on arrival and should not leave the hall without first obtaining permission from the referee. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
7. The Referee's decision shall be final on a point of law or in any dispute as to the interpretation thereof. Decisions on points of fact by the umpire shall be final.
8. It is a condition of entry that players agree to abide by the Code of Conduct of the ITTA and any other regulations for the tournament are published on the website: [www.ttulster.co.uk](http://www.ttulster.co.uk)

### General notes

The main advantage of this format is the time factor. All players will have played a minimum of five matches in the group plus two knockout matches and the event should be completed by 6 p.m. The tournament is ideal for players of all ages and abilities. At the conclusion of the event all players should be listed in an order reflecting their performance on the day.

**Refreshments** - there is no facility on site for sale of food, however, hot water will be available for own tea/coffee.

**Cash prizes** will be awarded to winners and runners-up in each of the three categories.
